## What is VAAC?

The Voting Accessibility Advisory Committee (VAAC) of Shasta and Tehama counties was established in 2014. The VAAC is designed to assist the county Election Departments with issues related to the accessibility of elections for seniors and individuals with disabilities.

## Volunteer Members Needed

Shasta and Tehama County Election Departments are seeking knowledgeable and committed individuals who would like to participate and serve on the VAAC as volunteer members.

## Responsibilities

- Attend the quarterly VAAC meetings in Tehama & Shasta counties.
- Make recommendations to improve access to voting and election materials.
- Provide advice about poll worker trainings and department websites.
- Assist in the review of accessibility of polling sites.



## What is VAAC's Role?

As a committee under the County Clerk/Registrar of Voters, members of the VAAC are essential in participating in the process of improving access to voting and election materials.

The VAAC provides recommendations that help ensure voters with disabilities and seniors can vote independently and privately. The VAAC also addresses issues such as accessible voting systems and polling sites, and discusses ways to improve the voting experience.
