LEARN TO MAKE COMPOST

The Tehama County Solid Waste Management Agency will be holding semi-annual backyard composting classes at our Agency office located at the Tehama County/Red Bluff Landfill. The classes will focus on starting a composting pile, how to keep your pile healthy, and what to do with finished compost.
