Textiles now accepted at the Tehama County/Red Bluff Landfill for Recycling

The Tehama County/Red Bluff Landfill is now accepting textiles for recycling free of charge (when segregated from the rest of your load). Common recyclable textiles include clothing items, clothing accessories (i.e. purses, handbags, backpacks, belts, etc.), and household textiles (i.e. bedspreads, sheets, blankets, drapes, quilts, towels, washcloths, linens, etc.).

Textiles must be self-hauled to the landfill, not placed in residential or commercial recycling service containers for pickup. When bringing your textiles to the landfill, please remember to segregate the material from the rest of your load and inform the scale house attendant that you will be dropping off textiles for recycling.

Unacceptable items for textile recycling include pillows, sleeping bags, mattresses*, rugs, carpet*, cushions, foam furniture, foam mats, vinyl shower curtains, large luggage, wet items, and smelly or moldy items.
