TO SCHEDULE AN INSPECTION PLEASE CALL 527-4928. TO RECEIVE A <u>NEXT DAY INSPECTION</u>, YOUR INSPECTION REQUEST MUST BE MADE **BY 3:30 PM** ON THE <u>BUSINESS DAY PRIOR</u> TO THE INSPECTION.

TO VERIFY INSPECTION TIMES PLEASE CALL 527-7002 AT 8:30 AM THE DAY OF YOUR SCHEDULED INSPECTION.

TO CANCEL AN INSPECTION PLEASE CALL **527-7002** BEFORE 7:30A.M.

THURSDAYS ONLY: Inspections in Manton, Paynes Creek, Ponderosa Sky Ranch, Mineral and Mill Creek areas.

WEDNESDAYS ONLY: Inspections in Rancho Tehama area.

IMPORTANT: If a correction list has been left, <u>all</u> items on the list shall be corrected prior to calling for a re-inspection. The correction list shall be left with the approved plans at the project site.

ANY CHANGES TO THE APPROVED PLANS SHALL BE SUBMITTED FOR APPROVAL <u>PRIOR</u> TO THE FINAL INSPECTION. (CHANGES TO ENGINEERED PLANS, <u>REQUIRE A LETTER FROM THE ENGINEER</u> TO THIS DEPARTMENT.)

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT

EVERY PERMIT ISSUED SHALL EXPIRE WITHIN (2) YEARS FROM THE DATE OF ISSUANCE, WITH THE FOLLOWING EXCEPTIONS: (MOBILE HOME SOFT SET: 6 MONTHS & AGRICULTURAL EXEMPT PERMIT: 1 YEAR

INSPECTIONS REQUIRED FOR NEW CONSTRUCTION

AFTER RECEIVING YOUR PERMIT, THE FOLLOWING INSPECTIONS MUST BE CALLED FOR AND APPROVED BY THE INSPECTOR <u>BEFORE</u> PROCEEDING:

FOUNDATION – rebar, forms & footings, pier holes, Simpson stab bolts UNDERSLAB PLUMBING – in place and under test, if applicable

UNDERFLOOR - after under floor framing, plumbing, HVAC duct work, gas/water piping have been installed, & placed under test, but **prior** to installation of insulation

UNDERFLOOR INSULATION – after installation

ROOF SHEATHING/STRUCTURAL - to include all structural inspection, sheathing, shear, trusses, and hold downs

FRAMING – all rough plumbing/electrical/mechanical/gas & water piping under test

WALL INSULATION - prior to installing sheetrock & after framing approved

STUCCO- scratch coat, brown coat and final

SHEETROCK NAILING - after installation, but prior to tape and texture

SHOWERPAN- for inspection of weep hole drainage

COUNTY CLEARANCES- County Fire, County Road/CalTrans, Environmental Health

FINAL INSPECTION- after job completed: CF6R forms req'd (CF4R if applicable), gas tag & certificate of occupancy to be issued

INSPECTIONS REQUIRED FOR MANUF. HOMES

BLOCKING/FOUNDATION SYSTEM/TIEDOWNS- For cinder blocking per plans & engineered foundation system installation

MARRIAGE LAGS- Lags & screws tying multiple units together, roof & walls CONTINUITY- to be conducted by owner/contractor and witnessed by inspector MANOMETER – to be conducted by owner/contractor and witnessed by inspector SERIAL & INSIGNIA – numbers verified for accuracy

ELECTRIC – Approved continuity test required for Electric Green Tag, to be conducted by owner/contractor and witnessed by inspector

FIRE SPRINKLERS- County Fire & Housing & Community Dept (HCD) inspections required. HCD approval of fire sprinklers must be submitted to office prior to final

SKIRTING – wood skirting requires 8" clearance above grade & venting 1 square inch per 150 s.f. of area
EXITS – LANDINGS & STAIRS- Max. 4'x4' area, more than 3 steps requires a grippable handrail, over 30" deck height requires a guard rail, 4" max. spacing between balusters (4 3/8" ok for stair balusters).
FINAL INSPECTION- Gas tag to be issued, certificate of occupancy (mobile home soft-set only)
433A recorded for mobile home permanent foundations- \$18.82 due at final for recording fee

INSPECTIONS REQUIRED FOR POOLS

EXCAVATION & STEEL- Pool location, rebar and excavation LIGHT NICHE – Location & bonding of any light fixtures in pool ELECTRIC BOND – Electric bonding of pool rebar & deck rebar if applicable ELECTRIC CONDUIT - Installation of conduit, trench depth, schedule 80 PVC above grade GAS PIPING TEST – Gas pipe under test, 10 psi WATER PIPING TEST – Water piping under test, working pressure EQUIPMENT FINAL – Equipment function, GFI plug at equipment BARRIER – Approved method of protection prior to plaster required POOL FINAL – Job complete, equipment functioning, barrier check

INSPECTIONS REQUIRED FOR MISCELLANEOUS

PROPANE TANK/GAS LINE – steel pipe 12" depth, plastic pipe 18" depth, green tag issued at final ELECTRIC – trench depth 18" in PVC conduit, 24" direct burial, green tag at final (DESTINATION REQ'D) DEMO – Disconnect of utilities and final PHOTOVOLTAIC – Labeling/signage required for final SIDING – Flashing and final HVAC- CF6R must be on site for inspection
