## DID YOU KNOW?



You can recycle your old **textiles like clothes, shoes, bedding and linens.**

**Here are some interesting facts about textile recycling:**

- More than **15 million tons** of textile waste is generated in the United States annually. That averages out to approximately **80 pounds** per American per year. Yikes!
- The **average lifetime** of a textile is approximately **three years.**
- More than **70 percent** of the world's population uses secondhand clothing.
- About 50% of collected textile material is given a second life as secondhand clothing, 20% is used to produce polishing and cleaning cloths, and 26% is recycled into products like **insulation, upholstery, fiberboard, mattresses, or re-woven into new clothing.**
- The Tehama County/Red Bluff Landfill **recycled 12,480 pounds** of textiles in 2019. That's slightly more than **three ounces per Tehama County resident.** We can do much better!

**Here's how you can give your clothing and other textile materials a new life:**

- **Donate gently used items to a local charity, resident in-need or friend.**
- Bring worn out textile materials to the Tehama County/Red Bluff Landfill to be recycled. Segregated textiles are accepted for **FREE.**
