- While spending time outside this summer, opt for reusable water bottles instead of disposable plastic bottles. Not only is it cheaper, but it reduces waste.
- •Many of us have paint in our garages leftover from various projects - don't let it sit around and waste away. Donate unwanted latex paint (must be in original containers with a label and a lid) to the Tehama County/Red Bluff Landfill's Paint Swap for reuse. While you're there, you might see some paint that you can reuse yourself.



- •Consider composting! You don't have to be an overachiever about it, either. Check out our website for tips and ideas!
- •Re-evaluate your need for chemical pesticides and herbicides. There are many alternatives to pest and weed control that do not require you to spray your property with harmful chemicals, polluting our water, soil and beautiful County.
