DID YOU KNOW?

Plenty of cleaning products can be made with everyday items in your cupboard, from baking soda to vinegar, and are often times less expensive and just as effective as the store bought cleaners.

- To make a simple **glass cleaner** try mixing ¼ to ½ cup of white vinegar with a quart of warm water in a spray bottle. Spray your windows or mirrors and wipe dry with a clean rag.
- A **nontoxic wood furniture polish** can be made very simply as well. In a small glass jar, mix ¼ cup of olive oil (or any other vegetable oil), ¼ cup

white vinegar, and 20-30 drops of lemon essential oil. Shake well before using. Dip a clean, dry cloth into the polish and rub the wood in the direction of the grain. Use a soft brush to work the polish into corners or tight places.

If you feel more comfortable with store bought cleaners, check out the Tehama County Solid Waste Management Agency's REuse of Available Products (REAP) facility before heading to the store. Please note the products change regularly so there is no guarantee what we will have. Call (530) 528-1103 for more information.

BEVERAGE CONTAINER RECYCLING... DONE RIGHT

No matter how you recycle, the County thanks you for your efforts. Here's a tip to maximize your recycling effort the next time you finish a refreshing, cold beverage:

- Take your aluminum, glass and plastic beverage containers to your local recycling center for a **cash refund** (5 ¢ for containers less than 24 oz. and 10 ¢ for containers 24 oz. or larger).
- Toss your rinsed beverage containers into your **blue curbside recycling cart** with your other recyclables.
