#### **Recyclable Paper Types:**

- White and colored paper (may contain staples, paper clips, sticky notes)
- Newspapers
- Magazines & catalogues
- Phone books
- Envelopes (with metal brackets and plastic windows -okay)
- Junk mail
- Cardboard or paperboard (please flatten)

#### **Recyclable Packaging Items:** Must be rinsed/free of residue...

- Aluminum cans; beverages, food, soup, etc.
- Plastic bottles or containers with a neck smaller than it's base only. All recycling numbers accepted.
- Milk cartons, drink cartons
- Glass bottles and jars

### Other Recyclable Items:

• Empty aerosol cans

## <u>NO</u>

- NO Styrofoam
- **NO** paper plates or cups with food residue
- NO liquids (empty cans/ containers before recycling)
- NO wide-mouth tubs/buckets
- NO frozen food, juice concentrate or microwaveable containers
- NO plastic bags, film, wrap or rubber bands
- **NO** paper or cardboard with large quantities of glue/tape
- NO laminated paper
- NO chemical or paint containers
- NO incandescent light bulbs

#### **Specialty Items:**

Call 528-1103 for special handling assistance...

- Fluorescent tubes and CFL light bulbs
- Batteries; alkaline and rechargeables
- Hazardous material
